**“Hosanna!”**



**T**he two Gospel readings today can give us emotional whiplash. As Mass Begins, we hear the story of Jesus’ triumphant entry into Jerusalem. We may even wave our own palm branches and join the crowd in shouting, “Hosanna! Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!” (Mark 11:9). Then, in the Liturgy of the Word, we hear Mark’s passion account. Once again, we join our voices with the crowd—but this time, we cry out, “Crucify him!” (15:13). How jarring!

Why does the Church have us play a role in both of these readings as we begin Holy Week?

It’s all for one purpose: so that we can grasp more fully what Jesus did for the crowds back then—and for us. As we will see throughout Holy Week, he accepted the suffering set before him and freely offered himself for his people, regardless of how they responded. Whether they acclaimed or condemned him, he loved them just the same. And that’s how he loves us.

Jesus is not put off by our fickleness. That’s good news! Because if we’re honest, we can all recognize times when our own commitment to the Lord and our love for him has wavered. When life is going well, it’s not so hard to praise him. But it can be another story altogether when danger threatens or sadness darkens our outlook.

So allow these passages to motivate you to pay attention to this final week in Christ’s life. Acknowledge the inconstancy of your own love for Jesus and ask him to strengthen you. But don’t stop there! Open your heart to the liberating truth that Jesus loves you even when you stray. Look at the cross and believe that he held you close to his heart throughout his passion, death, and resurrection.

May the Lord pour out graces on us all during this most holy week of the year!

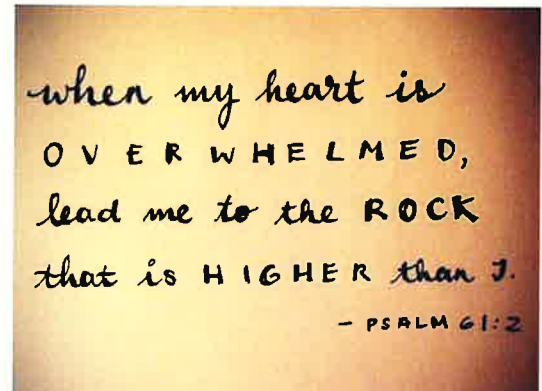





# Saint

Of the Week

## St. Berthold of Mount Carmel

Founder of the Carmelite Order  
Feast Day March 29

**S**aint Berthold is one of the key figures in the history of the Carmelite order. He was born in Limoges in western France and studied at the university in Paris, where he was an excellent student. His brother, Aymeric was a Latin patriarch in Antioch on the Orontes, the former capital of the Seleucids. In order to join his brother, Berthold took part in a crusade. During the siege of Antioch by the Saracen army, he had a vision. He saw Christ, who showed him the sins committed by Christian knights. These were supposedly the reasons for the unsuccessful fighting. Berthold embraced God's call to change the situation. He strove to set an example of a religious character to the Christian presence in the Holy Land.

### *The beginnings of the Carmelite order*

**H**e settled on Mount Carmel in Palestine and led a hermit's life. He was joined there by other hermits. Berthold wrote a rule for them that was approved by Aymeric during his stay in Palestine (1154 or 1160). The patriarch probably took along a group of monks from Mount Carmel to Antioch. Some of them settled in the city and some in the hermitage in nearby mountains.

**T**he rule written by Berthold became a model of the Carmelite rule. According to history, Berthold died on March 19, 1195. He is venerated by the Carmelites as a founder of the order. His grave is in the Wadi es Siah monastery

**H**istorians say that the Carmelite history has combined Berthold with the figure of the order's second general, Berthold of Lombardy, who took office around 1230. His cult was approved by the Congregation of Rites in 1564. History also mentions Berthold of Calabria, who was the order's first general probably in the late 12th century.



### **How to build a Carmelite Monastery reflecting Ancient Carmelite Architecture?**

Ancient Carmelite Architecture was based on the Carmelite Rule. Two aspects of the Carmelite Rule become the most important for designing a Carmelite Monastery. The first is the individual, separate cells. These cells need to be separated by a distance, each housing a single Carmelite who watches in prayer alone with God. The second is the beautiful Chapel where daily the community is to gather together for a solemnly chanted mass.



While praying one day a woman asked, "Who are you, God?" He answered, "I Am." "But who is, 'I Am'?" She asked. He replied, "I am Love, I am Peace, I am Grace, I am Joy, I am Strength, I am safety, I am Shelter, I am Power, I am the Creator, I am the Comforter, I am the Beginning and the End. I am the Way, Truth, and the Light." With tears in her eyes she looked toward heaven and said, "Now I understand. But, who am I?"
