**T**he words roll off our tongues so easily. Of course Jesus is God’s wisdom and power! He’s the Son of God, after all. But what do these words mean? Today’s readings can help us.

First, there’s Jesus as the *wisdom* of God. The story of the Ten Commandments in the first reading shows us that God’s commands are nothing more—and nothing less—than a revelation of his own divine wisdom. They reveal how he wants his children to live: by loving God and one another. This is the wisdom that Jesus lived out perfectly. In everything he said and did, he showed us what it is like to love God completely and to pour ourselves out in love for the people around us. And nowhere is this revealed more powerfully than when he laid down his life on the cross!

As for Jesus being the *power* of God,

what could be more astounding than his promise in today’s Gospel to rebuild the “temple of his body” after three days (John 2:21)? Imagine the kind of power it took for Jesus’ crucified, lifeless flesh to come back to life! Imagine the power that transformed his body into something radiant and glorious! *That* was a work that only God, by his own mighty power, could do!

These are not just historical facts. The power and wisdom of God are present today—and they’re yours in Christ! Every act of love, forgiveness, and generosity that you perform demonstrates his wisdom to a world lost in folly. Every time you pray in confident intercession, every time you rely on God’s grace to say no to temptation, and every time you lay down your life to care for someone, you are revealing the power of God.

That’s right. *You* can be God’s revelation to this world! ~ *The Word Among Us*

# What flower is named for Christ's Passion?

This striking bloom helped missionaries in their work.

Get Fed ~ Bite Sized Faith [Catholic Company]

Spanish missionaries named the stunningly unique bloom we know as the *passion flower*.

These missionaries traveled far from their homes, far from everything they knew, to bring the Light of Christ to the pagan peoples of the Americas. They met with every kind of hardship—from hunger to death to hardened hearts—but little by little, their work bore fruit and the Faith spread upon the new continents.

One of the things which encouraged the missionaries in their work was an elaborate, medium-sized flower they encountered. The flower clambered about on long, leafy vines, spreading a sweet fragrance in the air. It was primarily purple, with spiky filaments standing up about a little crown of anthers and stigma; its leaves unfurled into three points.

The missionaries, seeing the flower, took heart: it reminded them of Christ's Passion and the compelling reason they were toiling about in moist jungles, looking for souls. This is what they saw in the physical aspects of the flower and its plant:



**Purple:** the color of penance and sacrifice

**Five sepals and five petals:** the ten Apostles who neither betrayed Our Lord like Judas nor publicly denied Him like Peter (note that the missionaries weren't trying to slur Peter—who, unlike Judas, repented and became a great saint!)

**Three stigma:** the nails piercing Jesus' hands and feet

**Five anthers:** His five wounds

**Circlet of corona filaments:** the crown of the thorns

**Three-pointed leaves:** the Holy Trinity

**Vine:** God's attachment to the earth

The missionaries used this flower to teach people about the Passion. They sent descriptions of this miraculous plant back home. The Spanish people came to know it as "The Flower of the Five Wounds." Since then, the flower's name in almost every language has reflected its beautiful representation of the Passion.

## St. Perpetua

Patroness of Martyrs

Feast Day: March 7

One of the most moving examples of martyrdom is that of Perpetua, a young mother who converted to Christianity in 203. It was extremely dangerous to be a Christian during that time, and Perpetua was arrested along with several others. The prison was dark, crowded and unbearably hot. After friends arranged for her transfer to a more comfortable area, her mother brought her infant son to visit. He was allowed to stay so Perpetua could nurse him, but her father was greatly angered. Several times he begged her to deny her faith so she could be freed. But Perpetua refused, telling him her life lay “in the power of God.” At her trial, Perpetua was ordered to be thrown to the beasts in the arena. Her father was so enraged by her resolve, he took her son and refused to bring him back.

### *Martyrs All*

Arrested with Perpetua was a young slave, Felicity, who was eight months pregnant. Felicity actually wanted to be tortured with the others to show her faith and worried she would be held aside because of her condition. But just two days before the execution, she gave birth to a girl.

The morning of the games, Perpetua, a mere 22 years old, stepped into the arena, composed and radiant, with Felicity at her side. Perpetua refused to wear the traditional pagan costume and announced that she would rather die than worship their gods. The crowd roared and the Christians were attacked—the men by a boar, a bear and a leopard; the women by a rabid cow. Badly wounded, they all kissed each other and were put to death by a soldier’s sword.

Perpetua’s last words were to her brother. “Stand fast in the faith and love one another.”

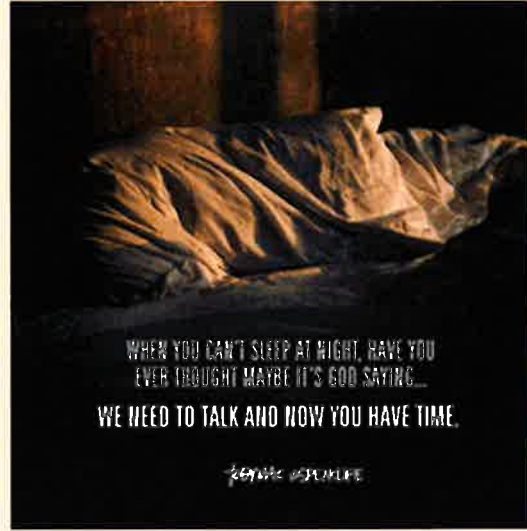
