of course they were astounded! The disciples and the parents of this young girl had just seen Jesus raise her from the dead. Now she was walking around as if she had never been ill. And just a few minutes earlier, a woman suffering from a hemorrhage for twelve long years had been instantly cured just by touching Jesus' cloak (Mark 5:27-29). Both were amazing displays of power, and both demonstrated that Jesus was no ordinary rabbi.

We don't know if the young girl's father or the afflicted woman really understood that Jesus was the Messiah when they reached out to him. But they must have sensed that he came from God, given what they already heard bout him. Clearly, they believed in his power enough to approach him for healing. Perhaps they didn't know how their encounter with him would end, but they put their hope in him and stepped out in faith.

We do know that Jesus is the Son of God,

and yet sometimes we can find ourselves doubting his power. Can he really heal me? Can he really forgive my most shameful sins? Will he one day raise me to new life? And yet the kinds of stories like the ones in today's Gospel reading didn't just happen in the past. Jesus still acts powerfully in our own time and place. Conversions, healings, answers to prayer—these continue to abound.

So believe in Jesus' power, as Jairus and this woman did. Step out in faith and ask for what you need. Keep asking even if you don't see immediate results. Even if it seems as if you're not getting what you're asking for, don't give up hope! Believe that Jesus, Lord of heaven and earth, has the power—and the desire—to heal you and give you new life. This is why he came to earth, and he will do it, in his own perfect time and way!

The office of SVDP will resume regular hours on Tuesday, July 9 & 10 from of 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.


### St. Clare Altar Society July meeting \*\*date change\*\*





### St. Thomas the Apostle

Patron of Builders, the blind and the East Indies

### Feast Day: July 3

homas was one of Jesus' 12 Apostles, but his name is only given in three of the Gospels. From his interaction with Jesus in the Gospel of John, though, he has been described as a devoted, impetuous and loving disciple.

A fter His friend Lazarus died, Jesus decided to go to Bethany even though He would be in grave danger. When Thomas heard this, he immediately said to the other disciples, "Let us also go to die with him." (John 11:16)

During the Last Supper, Jesus told the Apostles that IIe would be leaving soon. Promising to return one day, He added that they knew where he was going. Thomas interrupted and asked, "Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?" Jesus replied, "I am the way and the truth and the life." (John 14: 5-6)

### "Doubting Thomas"

Perhaps Thomas's most famous incident happened after Jesus' Resurrection. Thomas was not present when



Jesus first visited the Apostles. And when they told him they had seen Jesus, Thomas wanted proof. He said, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger into the nail marks and put my hand into his side, I will not believe." (John 20:25) A week later, only after Thomas actually saw and touched Jesus, did he exclaim, "My Lord and my God!" Gently rebuking him, Jesus said, "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." (John 20: 28-29)

O ne tradition holds that Thomas traveled farther than any other Apostle to spread Jesus' message. Another says Thomas preached in Syria, Persia and southern India, where he founded a Christian church and was martyred.









As we get further into our first month of this hurricane season, we continue to call upon our Lord, through the intercession of Our Lady, Star of the Sea, to watch over us and protect us from the storms that may threaten us, and turn our fears of your power into praise of your goodness.

Morning is God's way of saying one more time, go make a difference, touch a heart, encourage a mind, inspire a soul and enjoy the day.
