

September 29, 2024 26th Sunday in Ordinary Time "They prophesied in the camp."



Did you ever think that you might have missed God's blessing? Maybe you were supposed to go on a pilgrimage, but your finances fell through. Or you had hoped to attend a retreat, but someone in your family got sick. Or perhaps you had planned to go to daily Mass at noon, but you got stuck in a work meeting and couldn't get to church. How frustrating!

In today's first reading, Medad and Eldad might have felt the same way. Moses had chosen them to be among the seventy elders, and God had promised to place his Spirit upon them. They would be able to hear God's voice and help Moses care for the Israelites. But they had not gone out to the tent of meeting; they were left back in the camp among the hungry, complaining people. So it seemed that these two latecomers had missed their chance.

But God had other plans. He blessed them anyway—even in the chaos of the camp, even in their confusion. Medad and Eldad proclaimed God's word right in the midst of the people.

What does this teach us? First, it shows that God is able to bless us wherever we are. He's not limited by whether we're in the "right place at the right time." Second, he's not limited to working only through certain people. Medad and Eldad had willing hearts open to God's grace, and that helped them receive his Spirit. Joshua was scandalized and wanted to silence them, but Moses understood: the Lord's power and his desire to bless his people were far beyond what they had expected. He rejoiced—"Would that all the people of the Lord were prophets!" (Numbers 11:29).

You have not missed your chance to receive God's blessing! You're never beyond his reach, and it's never too late Today you can seek the Lord. He wants to shower his gifts and heavenly blessings upon you—no matter where you are!

Of the Week



Missionary

Francis Xavier Seelos was born on January 11, 1819 in the Bavarian city of Fussen. He came from a merchant family. Like most Bavarians, he was brought up in the Catholic faith, and he went to schools that taught in the Catholic spirit. He decided to enter a seminary while still a student at St. Stephen Institute in Augsburg. After his university studies in Munich, he entered a seminary in 1842. There he became familiar with the work of missionaries from the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer.

Later he joined the congregation in order to take care of immigrants in the United States. Soon young Francis was sent there to work.

He received permission from the authorities of the Redemptorist congregation and went on a mission in 1843. A year later he was ordained in Baltimore and settled down in the United States for good. For six years he worked in a parish in Pittsburgh; next he was appointed superior of the community and the Redemptorist novice master in Baltimore.


Missionary and teacher

Fr. Seelos continued his ministry, working for the poorest immigrants, making good use of his knowledge of several languages. In the seminary, he transferred to the students the knowledge, instilled int hem love of one's neighbor, and encouraged them to undertake missionary work, particularly among the poorest and immigrants from Europe. In the 1860s he traveled around the United States, spreading the Gospel. In 1866 he settled down in the parish of St. Mary of Assumption in New Orleans, where he died a year later during the yellow fever epidemic while taking care of the sick.

Francis Xavier Seelos was beatified on April 9, 2000.
