

December 8, 2024 Second Sunday of Advent

"God has commanded that every lofty mountain be made low, and that the age-old depths and gorges be filled."



Today's first reading contains a prophecy of what God would accomplish for the Jewish people as they languished in exile in Babylon. Baruch, scribe to the prophet Jeremiah, proclaims that "every lofty mountain" will be flattened and that "the age-old depths and gorges" will be filled in. So much so that the exiles would have a direct route, straight through the desert, back home (Baruch 5:7).

This was such good news! The only established road between Babylon and Jerusalem took travelers in a long northwesterly arc through the fertile land that surrounded the Syrian desert. But God was so eager to bring his people back to him that he promised to pave a new road directly through the wasteland. And even more amazing, he promised to join them on the journey, "leading Israel in joy...with his mercy and justice for company" (Baruch 5:9)!

What a perfect way to describe the miracle of

Christmas! God didn't wait for us to stumble through the wilderness of sin that separated us from him. He didn't stand on the border of the Promised Land and command us to make the treacherous journey on our own. He crossed that vast expanse to come to us. He entered this fallen world to offer us his "mercy and justice." Visiting the land of our exile, he now extends his hand and promises to lead us into his heavenly home.

Baruch tells us that God has "commanded" the mountains to flatten out and the chasms to be filled in (5:7). And when God speaks, creation obeys! No amount of pride or selfishness, no matter how tall, can withstand his command. No sin, no matter how grave, can carve a ravine too deep from him to fill. Jesus has paved a "new and living way" so that we can finally come home (Hebrews 10:20)!







Of the Week



St. Venantius Fortunatus Bishop of Poitiers Feast Day: December 3

Born around 535 near Treviso, a town close to Venice, Venantius Fortunatus grew up in a family that was wealthy enough to send him to Ravenna to be educated. There, he studied rhetoric and law, and seems to have embarked on a career as a scholar. In his late twenties, he contracted a disease that nearly blinded him. He was cured after rubbing his eyes with oil from a lamp burning in front of a statue of St. Martin of Tours.

After his recovery, Venantius decided to make a pilgrimage to Tours, a city in west central France about 150 miles from Paris, to give thanks to the saint. Adept at poetry and possessing courtly manners, Venantius extended this trip to several years, making himself comfortable in a number of houses owned by nobles.

Journey without Return


Venantius never returned home to Italy, which was being battered by petty wars. Instead, he settled in Poitiers, a city south of Tours. There, Queen Radegund, the estranged wife of the king of the Franks, Clotaire I, welcomed him to the monastery of the Holy Cross.

Pampered at Holy Cross, Venantius was persuaded by Radegund to join the priesthood and became chaplain and business and political adviser to the house. He also began to compose religious poems, many of which became the lyrics of well-known hymns. His *Vexilla Regis prodeunt* (The Royal Banners Go Forward), always sung on Good Friday during the Middle Ages, became one of the best-known hymns in the liturgy. In his late sixties, Venantius was appointed Bishop of Poitiers, but only lived a year following his consecration. He died around the year 605.
