"Do not be afraid."



nyone would have been afraid! Most Jews believed that if they saw the glory of God face-toface, they would die. This explains why St. John, who wrote the Book of Revelation, collapsed to the ground when he was brought into the presence of the "one like a son of man" (Revelation 1:13). Even John, who had walked with Jesus, witnessed his transfiguration, laid his head on Jesus' breast, and watched as he ascended to heaven, was overwhelmed!

Jesus' response to John is perfect for today's celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday: "Do not be afraid" (Revelation 1:17). He didn't tell John that there was no reason to fear; he touched him, offered a word of encouragement, and raised him up. That expression of love and intimacy overcame John's fears and enabled him to stand before his glorious Lord. That's what mercy is all about! It's the perfect love of God, which "drives out fear" (1 John 4:18).

This is the same mercy Jesus showed to

Thomas in today's Gospel. Thomas doubted the resurrection because he hadn't seen it with his own eyes. But Jesus came and invited Thomas to touch his wounds and "believe" (John 20:27). Like John, Thomas experienced a mercy that saw his unworthiness and still drew him close.

We can experience that mercy, too. Jesus knows that in the light of his glory, we are all frail and flawed. He knows that in the light of his truth, we often doubt and distrust. He knows we are not worthy to come to him on our own merits. Yet in his power and holiness and glory, he is patient with us. As he did for Thomas, he sees our weakness and shores up our faith. As he did for John, he calms our fearful hearts and assures us of his love.

So don't be afraid to come to Jesus today. Don't be afraid to let him see you as you truly are. Come and hear him say, "Do not be afraid."

# Of the Week



Patroness of Italy and Women Involved in Catholic Action

C atherine was born in the mid-14th century into a large, wealthy family in Siena, Italy. From an early age, she chose to devote herself to Christ rather than marry and seek material comforts, despite her parents' strong objections. Once Catherine chose this path, she experienced numerous divine visions. In one extraordinary experience, she felt she had actually exchanged her heart for Christ's. In another, she believed that she had received the stigmata, even though she prayed for the marks to remain invisible.

Throughout her life, as a sign of her spiritual devotion. Catherine ate barely enough to sustain her. She was driven in her commitment to reach out to everyone. Although she could not write, she dictated

many letters, offering spiritual advice to rich and poor alike.

# Ambassador for God.

Catherine became well known for her spiritual conviction and wisdom, which proved immensely valuable, especially during The Great Schism when the Church was beset by conflict and corruption. The clergy had imposed heavy taxes to maintain their luxurious lifestyles. Italians were further upset because the Church was centered in Avignon, France, rather than in Rome. When the Italian state of Florence rebelled against the Papacy, Pope Gregory XI chose Catherine as an ambassador to mediate.

Catherine succeeded in persuading the Pope to return to Rome. While she stood up for the Pope, she still encouraged Church reforms, denouncing the indulgent lifestyles of the clergy. Meanwhile, she continued to communicate her deepest spiritual thoughts and feelings, dictating prayers and meditations that have become classics of Italian religious literature.


