(5 kilo (11 lbs.) rice, 1 gal cooking oil, cans tomato paste, canned fish, beans – black eyed peas & red beans, spaghetti) Rice and oil will be purchased in Ghana (Monetary donations needed to purchase food in Ghana).

> Accessories for those who we will support attending trade school:

Tailoring for Boys. Sewing machine, measuring tape, Pincushions and pins, Sewing shears, Needle threaders, Tape measures, Hand sewing needles, bodkins, rotary cutters

Sewing for Girls. Sewing machine, measuring tape, Seam ripper, sewing threads, Fabric marking tool, fabric scissors, pins and pincushion, Iron and ironing board

Hair styling for Girls. Styling tools: high quality scissors, combs, and brushes for hair styling, Salon cart: to keep styling tools organized and close at hand, Hair dryers, curling Iron, Towels

- Medical Supplies (Village Clincs & Hospital): (Over the counter medicines)
 Ibuprofen- tablets/liquid for adults and children, Acetaminophen (Tylenol) tablets/liquid for adults and children, Aspirin 325mg tablets/liquid for adults and children,
