

Every year on Holy Thursday, the king or queen of England distributes gifts to various men and women who have demonstrated “outstanding Christian service” by making a difference in the lives of their local communities.

This image of a good and generous king is appropriate today, even if it isn’t Holy Thursday! That’s because today marks one hundred years since Pope Pius XI established the feast of Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. Today, instead of considering an earthly king, we turn our attention to the “King of kings and Lord of lords” (Revelation 19:16), whose “kingdom will have no end” (Nicene Creed).

Jesus, our King, came to give us greater gifts than any gift an earthly king could ever give. In today’s Gospel, in fact, we see him giving the gift of eternal life to the “good thief” who is crucified next to him. Then, dying on the cross, he gave

us the greatest gift: his own life for our salvation. And from that point on, he has been continuously offering us his love, mercy, and forgiveness. As Pope Pius XI proclaimed, Jesus came, “not to be ministered unto but to minister,” and to give himself “as a model of humility” (*Quas Primas*, 20). What a wonderful King we have!

When the thief on the cross asked Jesus to remember him, Jesus promised, “Today you will be with me in Paradise” (Luke 23:43). Let’s follow this man’s example and honor our King by surrendering our lives to him. Let’s open our hands and receive his overflowing gifts of mercy, love, and forgiveness. Most of all, let’s praise our King for giving us the greatest gift of all: eternal life!



# Saints

Of the Week



## St. Leonard of Port Maurice

Patron of Parish Missions, Missionaries and  
Imperia, Italy

Feast Day: November 26

**B**orn in Italy in 1676, Paolo Girolamo was 13 when his father, a sea captain, sent him to live with his uncle in Rome to study medicine. When Paolo found himself drawn to a religious life, his uncle disowned him. Sad but not discouraged, Paolo joined the Franciscans and took the name Leonard. After completing his studies at San Bonaventura Friary, he was ordained in 1702.

Leonard wanted to be a missionary in China, but illness forced him to remain at San Bonaventura and teach philosophy. After his recovery, he helped establish a home at San Francesco del Monte for friars who preached missions throughout Tuscany. Later, he founded a hermitage nearby where the friars could renew their spirits through fasting, prayer and solitude.

### Preacher and Writer

Leonard was an eloquent speaker whose preaching “touched the hearts of all.” Responsible for numerous conversions, he was frequently invited to speak in other areas of Italy, including Rome, Umbria and Genoa. As his popularity grew, he often had to preach outdoors in order to accommodate the large crowds.

Leonard was also a prolific writer whose sermons, letters and books of devotion have been translated into several languages. He promoted several Catholic devotions, erected over 500 stations of the cross throughout Italy and suggested that the Immaculate Conception be defined as a dogma of faith 100 years before the Church did so.

Exhausted by his work, Leonard returned to San Bonaventura, where he died. Considered the patron of parish missions, he was canonized in 1867.
