

The 2nd Sunday in Ordinary Time

***“...called to be holy,
with all those every-
where who call upon
the name of our Lord
Jesus Christ.”***



At the beginning of his first letter to the Corinthians, St. Paul says that he was “called to be an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God” (1 Corinthians 1:1). That calling changed him and reoriented his life. Then he goes on to tell the Corinthians that God had called them, too — to be holy, with everyone else who calls upon the name of Jesus (1:2). Through Baptism, they had been called to see and love each other as fellow members of Christ’s body.

This was an important reminder for the Corinthians because Paul goes on to tackle some problems he has heard about in their community, starting with factionalism and disunity. Paul urges them, in light of their calling, “that there be no divisions among you, but that you be united in the same mind and in the same purpose” (1 Corinthians 1:10). God had called them to be part of his own family, and that meant allowing him to uproot any selfishness or pride

that would give rise to prejudices, divisions, and other barriers between them.

Today we begin the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity, and this year’s theme comes from Ephesians 4:4: “There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to the one hope of your calling.” That might remind you of today’s first reading. We are called, and that calling changes us. It’s meant to lead us to unity with everyone who belongs to Jesus. It’s meant to urge us to love each other to the point that we’re united.

So how do we start? A first step is to let Jesus help you see and love other Christians as fellow members of his body. So for the rest of this week, join believers around the world in praying the daily prayers for unity. You can find them starting on page 10 of the January issue of *The Word Among Us*.





# Saint of the Week

## St. Fabian

Feast Day: January 20th ~ Patron of Rome



Fabian was living as an obscure Christian farmer at the time of Pope Anteros's death in 236. Traveling to Rome with other Christian brethren, this unknown lay person sat in on the council convened to choose a new Pope—a far less formal process in the early days of Christianity. Suddenly, a dove landed on Fabian's head. Seeing this as a sign from God, the assembly shouted, "Worthy!" and unanimously elected the stunned Fabian as the next pontiff.

For the next eight years, Fabian ministered to a Church that was largely underground because of the persecutions led by Roman authorities.

However, in 244, Philip the Arabian, a friend to the growing Church, overthrew the hostile Emperor Gordian III. As a result, Christianity flourished.

### Period of Progress

Fabian set to work, creating seven districts of Rome, each administered by a deacon. He ordered the court records of martyred Christians to be collected for posterity. And had the body of Pope Pontianus brought from Sardinia and re-interred in the catacomb of Callistus, which was adorned with murals. Fabian also consecrated seven bishops to minister to Gaul, one of whom was Denis, who would later become a saint.

This golden period did not last. Anti-Christian violence increased as Romans became resentful of the Church's growth. When Emperor Philip Died in 249 after a five-year reign, his successor, Decius, outlawed Christianity. In the brutal persecutions that followed, Pope Fabian was the first victim in Rome. He was buried in the Catacomb of Callistus.


