Third Sunday in Easter

***“He was made known to them in the breaking of the bread.”***



**H**ave you ever noticed how the story of the two disciples meeting Jesus on the road to Emmaus looks a lot like the way we meet Jesus at every Mass?

At the start, Cleopas and his friend were devastated. Jesus had been crucified, and their hopes were dashed. So when Jesus approached them, “their eyes were prevented from recognizing him” (Luke 24:16). How often do we come to Mass preoccupied? Maybe we had an argument on the way to church, or we’re worried about a family problem. These things can keep us from seeing Jesus clearly.

Jesus didn’t keep his distance. He drew near and engaged with these two disheartened disciples. Similarly, he welcomes us to Mass as we are and draws near to us. In the Penitential Rite, he offers us his mercy so that we can turn from our sins and refocus our minds on him.

Once Jesus started the conversation with his disciples, he walked them through “what referred to him in all the Scriptures” (Luke 24:27). In the

Liturgy of the Word, Jesus teaches us. The readings can open our hearts and minds to God’s perfect plan, fulfilled in him.

Although the disciples’ hearts were burning as they began to understand the Scriptures, they didn’t recognize Jesus until he took, blessed, broke, and gave bread to them. In the Liturgy of the Eucharist, our eyes are opened and our faith deepened as Jesus offers himself to us in Holy Communion!

Next, the two disciples immediately and joyfully returned to Jerusalem to tell their friends. At the end of Mass, we are sent out to “go and announce the Gospel of the Lord.” Meeting Jesus changes our hearts, and we can’t help but proclaim it.

The next time you’re at Mass, imagine that Cleopas and his companion are with you. Share their excitement as, throughout the liturgy, your heart begins to burn with love as you come to recognize Jesus, present in the breaking of the bread.

# Saint of the Week

## St. Mark, the Evangelist

**Feast Day: April 25 ~~ Patron of Venice, Egypt, Notaries & Basket Weavers**



**B**orn early in the first century, Mark is the writer of the second Gospel. Many scholars identify the young man who fled upon Jesus' arrest in Mark's Gospel as Mark himself. As the Scripture reads, the young man was wearing only a linen cloth that night. When the soldiers moved to arrest him, too, he ran off naked, leaving the cloth in the soldiers' hands, and abandoned Jesus to His enemies.

Mark may also be the John Mark mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles. His mother's house was a meeting place for Christians in Jerusalem, and he traveled with his cousin Barnabas and Paul on their first missionary trip. But it was Mark's relationship with the Apostle Peter, who called him "Mark, my son" (1 Peter 5:13), that primarily influenced the Gospel according to Mark.

Mark worked closely with Peter to build the Christian community in Rome. Some time before 60, Roman Christians asked Mark to write down the stories about Jesus that he had heard from Peter. In fact, Peter's voice is so prevalent in Mark's Gospel that Church historians in the next century described Mark as Peter's "interpreter,"

### Mark's Final Years

According to tradition, after Peter's death, Mark traveled to the Roman province of Alexandria, Egypt, where he established the first Christian school. Later, as Nero began persecuting Christians throughout the Roman Empire, Mark was arrested. His captors tortured him, binding him with cords and dragging him across jagged stones. Still, Mark would not renounce Christ.

While the evangelist awaited execution, an angel visited him in his prison cell. It is also said that during this final test of faith, Jesus came and comforted Mark.
