The Ascension of the Lord

***“May...God...give you  
a Spirit of wisdom  
and revelation  
resulting in  
knowledge of him.”***



**T**oday, on the feast of the Ascension of the Lord, we ponder Jesus’ victory over death and the grave. We lift our hearts to imagine Jesus as he “mounts his throne amid shouts of joy” and takes his seat at his Father’s right hand in glory (Psalm 47:6). And what better way to lift up our hearts than by recalling the truths proclaimed in today’s first reading!

Jesus is seated at God’s right hand “in the heavens” (Ephesians 1:20). The right hand has traditionally been a position of royal power and influence. *Jesus, you rule over the universe from your throne of divine glory!*

He is “far above every principality, authority, power, and dominion” (1:21). There is nothing or no one more powerful than Jesus. He is over everyone and everything. *Lord, nothing surpasses you; you have the final word!*

All things have been placed “beneath his feet” (1:22). Everything—even sin and death—has

been subjected to him. *Jesus, you have defeated every power that stands against you. And you have made us sharers in that victory!*

He has been given to the Church as “head over all things” (1:22). He is the supreme authority over all believers. *Jesus, you uphold, confirm, and defend your Church at all times! It’s your power that keeps us going!*

He “fills all things in every way” (1:23). His presence fills every part of the universe. He is never absent from us. *Jesus, you are forever present to us throughout all space and time!*

What do we do with this glorious knowledge? We can imitate the disciples, who stood gazing at the heavens as they saw Jesus lifted up (Acts 1:11). And we can follow his command in today’s Gospel: “Go...and make disciples of all nations” (Matthew 28:19).

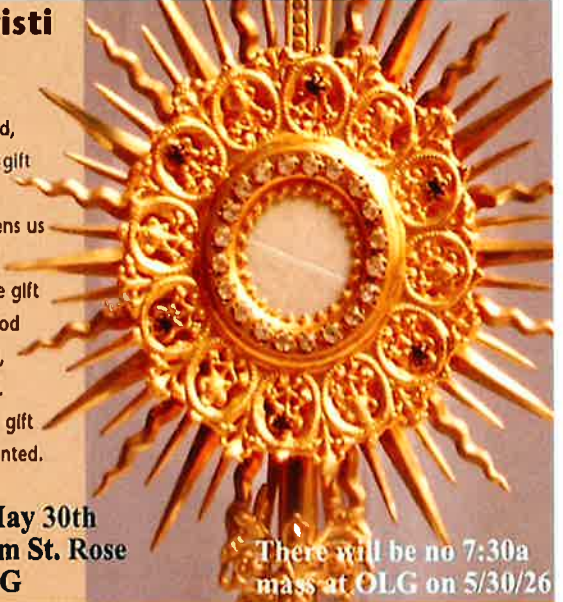

# Saint of the Week

## St. Leonard Murialdo

**Feast Day: May 18 ~ Patron of Vocational School Students and Apprentices**



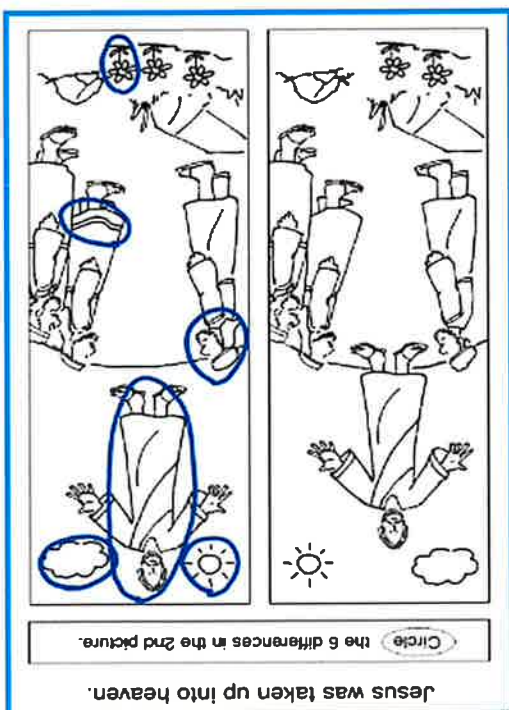
**L**eonard Murialdo was born in Turin on October 26, 1828. He completed the Piarist secondary school in Savonna. He returned to his home town to study theology. In 1851, at the age of 23, he obtained a doctoral degree and was ordained. He soon found a common language with the city's top ministers, for example, Joseph Cafasso and St. John Bosco. He appreciated their merciful acts. But also he realized that major social problems needed to be solved through a change in the social system, not only by acts of charity. He sought inspiration from Christian activists in France and Germany who co-created social Catholicism.

He took over the running of the once excellent, but then deteriorating, Turin Crafts College.

There he noticed the importance of bringing up young people in a way that combines religious development and vocational education. He devoted 34 years to this work. In 1873 he founded the Society of St. Joseph of Turin.

He undertook tasks similar to those implemented by John Bosco, but he attached more attention to organizing the workers' and craftsmen's lives. He put forward bold social slogans that were ahead of his time; for example, he fought for an eight-hour workday. His uncompromising attitude earned him the reputation as a socialist. But he was not a political activist; he was just an educated man with a great heart. In private, he was a fan of swimming and mountain climbing.

He died in Turin on March 30, 1900. He was beatified in 1963, and Pope Paul VI canonized him in 1970.
