11th Sunday in Ordinary Time

**“How
much
more.....”**



This passage can seem so complex that we might feel tempted to gloss over it. But don't! Spend a little time with it, and you'll see that it is filled with words of great encouragement and promise.

First, Paul explains that Jesus offered himself up for us “while we were helpless” (Romans 5:6). He admits that we were trapped in sin and unable to pull ourselves out of it. If anything, we kept digging ourselves into a deeper hole. But, Paul proclaims, that's what makes Jesus' sacrifice so astounding. *He gave his life for me when I was in such a sorry state!*

Paul says, in fact, that this is how God “proves” how much he loves us: “While we were still sinners Christ died for us” (Romans 5:8). Jesus' cross forever stands as the evidence that no matter how low we may fall, no matter how selfish and prideful we may be, God still loves us. He still wants to rescue us and restore us to himself.

Having explained how God proves his love for us, Paul goes on to describe the confidence this love can give us. And he does it back stacking one rhetorical question on top of another: if Jesus has rescued us by his death, *how much more* will he protect us from “the wrath’ that sin produces in the world (5:10)? How much more indeed! There's no limit to his love.

So every time you catch yourself wondering whether you are “good enough” for Jesus to love you, remember those three words: *how much more!* Remember the cross. Remember the love that moved him to give himself up to death—for you. Gaze upon the cross and let Jesus tell you how valuable and how precious you are to him. Then stand tall and joyfully “boast” to yourself about the love that God has for you. (Romans 5:11). Rejoice in the love that redeems and reconciles and saves and heals. The love that does *so much more.*

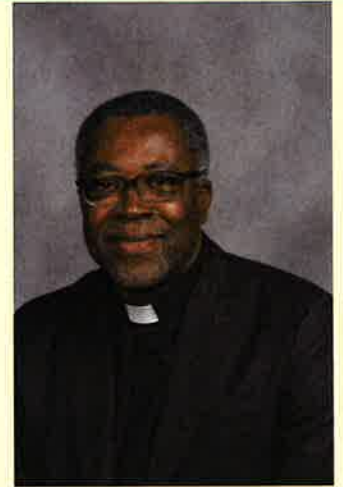
## Over 50's Monthly Activities!



# Saint of the Week

## St. Lutgardis

Feast Day: June 16

Patroness of Blind and Disabled People



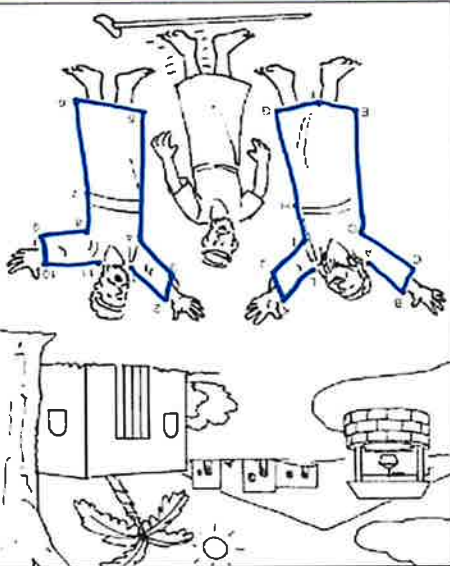
**L**utgardis was born in medieval Belgium. She was sent to a Benedictine monastery at the age of twelve, because her family didn't have enough money to marry her off. Her strong attraction to worldly things, like nice clothes and attention from suitors, made her first years in the monastery very difficult. She was deeply unhappy and would often run away.

That all changed one day. When she was twenty years old, Jesus appeared to her in a mystical vision. Lutgardis fell into a state of awe. Jesus showed her his wounds, and brought her face to face with the reality that her soul was starving, and it was time to feed it. From that day on, Lutgardis would live soulfully for the remainder of her life.

After the vision, Lutgardis decided to stay in the monastery the rest of her life. She took her vows to be a Benedictine nun. She fed her soul every day with prayer. In particular, she embraced spiritual reading and built the habit of *Lectio Divina*, the practice of meditation on a biblical passage.

Saint Lutgardis had a miraculous vision. But it's what she did next that mattered most. She made a conscious decision to grow closer to God every day. She knew that in the spiritual life, you're either getting closer to God or falling farther away from him. She lived soulfully.

You cannot stand still in the spiritual life. You can't take a break. That's like trying to stand still in the midst of a gushing river. You are either moving upstream or being pushed downstream—and only a dead fish floats downstream. And yet, moving upstream is not all about making a heroic effort to do spiritual things. It is as much about consciously making an effort to receive everything that God is pouring into you and learning to simply be with God.
