13th Sunday in Ordinary Time

“Whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me.”



Did you know that this is the first time the cross is mentioned in Matthew’s Gospel? It comes at a time when Jesus is commissioning the Twelve to go out preaching and healing. Jesus doesn’t directly predict his own death, either. He’s telling his closest followers the conditions of discipleship!

We might not quite grasp what a challenging statement Jesus was making. As Christians, we might think that taking up the cross means bearing life’s burdens, whether they be inconveniences, sickness, or hardship. And that’s not wrong.

But his disciples would have understood that the call to take up their cross meant something much more radical. Crucifixion was a feared, brutal, shameful manner of execution. So they understood that Jesus was telling them to be willing to give up *everything* to follow him and witness to him—even their lives, if necessary. It’s not so different from what Jesus had said

just before this: whoever loves father or mother, son or daughter more than him is not worthy of him (Matthew 10:37). Even important family ties must be second to our commitment to Jesus.

This is not an easy message. But consider who is asking it of us. Jesus is not merely a teacher or philosopher. He’s not simply a compassionate wonder-worker or dedicated advocate for the poor. He is God himself. Of course we should have nothing above God in our lives!

Consider also that the One who asks this of us lived out this command perfectly. He humbled himself and laid down his life to free us from sin and death and restore us to the Father. How could we respond with anything less?

Today, hear Jesus’ demanding call. Ask him for the grace to follow him wholeheartedly.

# Saint of the Week

## St. Paul

Feast Day: June 29

Patron of Evangelists and Lay People



**W**hen St. Paul was born in Tarsus around the year 3, he was named Saul. He was from a wealthy family and followed Jewish law zealously. As a young man, Saul believed that Christianity should be destroyed. He had not met Christ, but Saul aggressively persecuted Christians, dragging them out of their homes to prison. Saul even watched approvingly as St. Stephen was stoned. But on the road to Damascus to arrest a group of Christians, an extraordinary event occurred, changing his life forever.

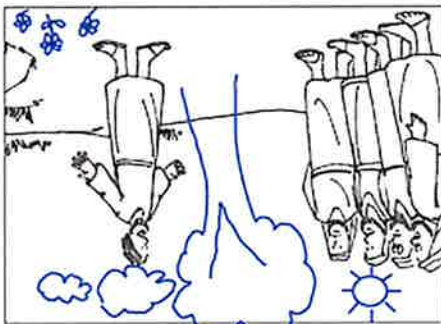
A light flashed, blinded Saul and knocked him to the ground. Then a voice said, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting me?" (Acts 9:4) Saul knew it was Jesus. When he could see again three days later, he saw with his eyes and with his heart. Saul became Paul and set forth to carry Jesus' word.

### A Brave Missionary

Paul first began preaching in Damascus. The tables turned, and now Paul was being persecuted by people who disagreed with his teachings. Once, in the dead of night, his friends lowered him from the city wall in a basket to avoid his being killed. People were astounded by Paul's

miraculous change of heart; even the Apostles did not trust him at first.

Paul dedicated himself to preaching, writing and founding churches. He took three missionary trips, during which he faced constant danger. He was stoned, scourged, shipwrecked and imprisoned. Everywhere he went, including prison, he sent epistles, or letters to his Christian communities, offering them courage and advice about following Christ's teachings. In the year 65, the man who persecuted so many in his youth was martyred in Rome as a Christian. The power of his words still resonates today.
